Specialism: Committees!

Faculty Reps sit on University-level committees such as Faculty Boards and Senate to help influence Policy making across the wider University.

Committees?

Attending relevant meetings such as Faculty Board, Faculty Learning & Teaching Group (FLTG), IT Committee, Library Committee and Senate.

Top Tasks

Preparing thoroughly for, and attending the committees you sit on to ensure you can effectively challenge policies or key decisions if needed.

Supporting Department Reps by bringing major issues to the attention of the Faculty.

Running termly Faculty Forums with Department Reps to promote best practice and highlight any larger issues

Closing the feedback loop by regularly updating both the Academic Leadership Team and the student body on your impact, experiences and manifesto progress.

Project Work?

Faculty Reps run projects based on their manifesto priorities and use the Department Reps as team players to help deliver the projects.

Hours per Week?

Around **5 hours** per week during term time.
