Time commitment: 3-5 hours per week. Hours may be more or less dependent on the time of year (during key events such as National Student Volunteering Week) and is dependent on each officer's manifesto and priorities.

- To recruit Volunteering Committee as well as hold and chair at least 3 meetings per term.

- To implement and uphold the Constitution, Bye-Laws and Policy of the Union
- To be accountable to the student body by attending and presenting at Officer Group and any other required meetings
